Your affairs in order in the Netherlands

Yacht Expat Services is there for you even before you start your new job in the Netherlands. Below, you can read more about what to expect from us.

Searching for a place to live

We know exactly how important it is to have a nice place to live. Yacht Expat Services can help you find one. We will start our search as soon as the application for your residence and work permit has been submitted. Initially, we will search for a residence for you alone - and your partner, if you wish - but not for your family. In our experience, it is best to start your new job in the Netherlands by yourself at first. Once you have settled in properly on a professional and personal level, it is time to start looking for a suitable place to live for you and your partner or family. Of course, we will help you with that as well. For example, we can introduce you to real estate agents and take care of the permit applications for your partner and/or family.

Your journey to the Netherlands

Your employment agreement has been finalized and your work permit has arrived. The next step is your journey to the Netherlands. Generally, you will arrive in our country in the week before the start of your employment agreement. In most cases, Yacht will book your flight for you. If you would rather do that yourself, e.g. because you want to choose your arrival time or date, that is fine too, as long as you let us know in advance!

Help with important appointments

You can count on intensive guidance during your first few days in the Netherlands. For example, we will accompany you to a number of important appointments. Upon leaving the airport, you will first be taken to your new residence, which we will look at together. Next up is a visit to the expat center, where we will pick up your work permit. Possibly, your biometric information has to be recorded here as well (if the embassy did not already do so or did not submit this information on time). At the expat center's municipal office, you will register as a citizen of the municipality where you will live and you will receive your Dutch social security number (known as a BurgerServiceNumber or BSN). We will also help you open a new bank account.

Getting started

You are seconded by Yacht to your client. In most cases, there will be a meeting with your supervisor at Yacht before you get started. During this meeting, we will go over your assignment and the ins and outs of working for our organization, among other things.

Moving to a new country for work can be a daunting process. You may therefore have some questions of your own. Yacht Expat Services is your point of contact for anything you want to know, e.g. about:

- The 30% ruling;
- Your health insurance and healthcare in the Netherlands;
- DigiD, your digital identity that you need for various things;
- Your driver's license;
- Public transport facilities.

Here's what we expect from you

We only present professionals to our clients who are actually authorized to live and work in this country. It is therefore essential that you meet and continue to meet the requirements of the knowledge migrants regulation. As a knowledge migrant, you therefore have an information obligation towards the IND and Yacht itself.

That means you must inform us about any situations that (may) affect your residence and career in this country. At the very least, you must let us know if you plan to e.g.:

- Go on (unpaid) leave for an extended period of time;
- Travel to a non-EU country;
- Reduce your work hours;
- Quit your job.

We expect you to inform us about any such changes in a timely manner (at least four weeks in advance). That will give us enough time to report any changes to the IND and it ensures you have the time you need to comply with applicable laws and regulations.

If you are the partner of a knowledge migrant and you are registered with Yacht as the "partner of," your partner - not Yacht - will be your so-called "sponsor". It is important for both the IND and Yacht that the sponsorship in question is intact. For example, if your relationship should come to an end, you must inform both the IND and Yacht about this, because it affects your right to work in the Netherlands.

Going abroad

If you have a permit to live and work in the Netherlands, you can travel freely within the EU. You may also travel to countries outside the EU, as long as you return to the Netherlands within three months.
